About the role

The Camp Cook is responsible for planning, preparing and cooking nutritious home style meals in our permanent camp based 70km from the homestead. You will cook breakfast, morning tea, lunch and dinner for approximately 12-20 people, which fluctuates with station contractors and stock staff. The camp has a fully contained, air-conditioned stainless steel kitchen and dining area. There will be opportunities to be able to go mustering, yard work and educating weaners.

Duties include:

- Preparing tasty, nutritious, home-style meals four times a day for around 12-20 team members (breakfast, morning tea, lunch and dinner)
- Menu and food stores planning, liaising with Station Cook on orders
- Keeping a clean and tidy camp
